1. NATURE OF OPERATIONS

Peoples Gas WV LLC (the Respondent) engages in the purchase, storage, distribution and transportation of natural gas. The Respondent is a wholly-owned subsidiary of PNG Companies LLC (PNG Companies). Effective December 17, 2013, PNG Companies acquired all membership interests of Equitable Gas Company, LLC (EGC), from EQT Corporation (EQT). The EGC assets were split by state of operations into separate legal entities for West Virginia (the Respondent) and Kentucky, and the Pennsylvania assets were combined into Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC.

PNG Companies LLC is a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of LDC Holdings LLC, which is in turn a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of LDC Funding LLC. The ultimate parent in the ownership chain is SteelRiver Infrastructure Fund North America LP and an affiliated fund.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

General — The Respondent makes certain estimates and assumptions in preparing its financial statements in accordance with GAAP. These estimates and assumptions affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements, and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses for the periods presented. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

Accounting for Regulated Operations — The Respondent's distribution rates, terms of service and contracts with affiliates are subject to comprehensive regulation by the WV Public Service Commission (WV PSC). The accounting for regulated gas operations differs from the accounting for nonregulated operations in that the Respondent is required to reflect the effect of rate regulation in the financial statements. For regulated businesses subject to federal or state cost-of-service rate regulation, regulatory practices that assign costs to accounting periods may differ from accounting methods generally applied by nonregulated companies. When it is probable that regulators will permit the recovery of current costs through future rates charged to customers, these costs are deferred as regulatory assets. Likewise, regulatory liabilities are recognized when it is probable that regulators will require customer refunds through future rates or when revenue is collected from customers for expenditures that are not yet incurred. Regulatory assets are amortized into expense and regulatory liabilities are amortized into income over the period authorized by the regulator.

The Respondent evaluates whether or not recovery of its regulatory assets through future regulated rates is probable and makes various assumptions in its analyses. The expectations of future recovery are generally based on orders issued by regulatory commissions or historical experience, as the well as discussions with applicable regulatory authorities. If recovery of a regulatory asset is determined to be less than probable, it will be written off and an expense will be recorded in the period such assessment is made.

Accounting records are maintained in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts prescribed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and applicable state commissions.

Operating Revenue — Operating revenue is recorded on the basis of services rendered, commodities delivered, or contracts settled, and includes amounts yet to be billed to customers. The Respondent's receivables from customers, of accrued unbilled revenue, are based on estimated amounts of natural gas delivered, but not yet billed, to its utility customers. The Respondent estimates utility unbilled revenue based on historical usage, applicable customer rates, and weather factors.

Unrecovered Gas Costs — The differences between actual purchased gas expenses and the levels of recovery for these expenses in current rates are deferred and matched against recoveries in future periods. This deferral is recognized as a net regulatory asset and classified as unrecovered gas costs.

Income Taxes — The Respondent is a single-member limited liability company treated as a disregarded entity for United States federal and West Virginia state income tax purposes. The Company's taxable income or loss is included in the federal and state tax returns filed by LDC Funding LLC. The Company calculates its share of the federal and state tax expense and benefits of LDC Funding LLC based on the amounts that would be reported if it were to file tax returns on a separate-company basis.

Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) ASC 740, Income Taxes, requires an asset and liability approach to accounting for income taxes. Deferred income tax assets and liabilities are provided, representing future effects on income taxes for temporary differences between the basis of assets and liabilities for financial reporting and tax purposes. Where permitted by regulatory authorities, the treatment of temporary differences may differ from the requirements of ASC 740. For those temporary differences, a regulatory asset is recognized if it is probable that future revenues will be provided for the payment of deferred tax liabilities; as a result, only a provision for the current tax expense is included in the determination of net income. The Respondent has not identified any uncertain tax positions as of December 31, 2013.

Cash and Cash Equivalents — Current banking arrangements generally do not require checks to be funded until actually presented for payment. At December 31, 2013, accounts payable included \$3,598 of checks outstanding but not yet presented for payment. The Respondent considers cash and cash equivalents to include cash on hand, cash in banks and temporary investments purchased with an original maturity of three months or less.

Inventories — Materials and supplies inventories are valued primarily using the weighted-average cost method. The Company has stored gas inventory under the weighted-average cost method, which is valued at \$2,094,163 at December 31, 2013.

3. LONG-TERM DEBT

Under an Intercompany Promissory Note dated December 31, 2013, the amount of \$14,000,000, outstanding principal was issued. The funding available to the Repondent in connection with this intercompany note is dependent upon PNG Companies' compliance with its Note Purchase Agreement dated December 12, 2013, under which notes totaling \$414,000,000 were outstanding with third-party lenders at December 31, 2013.

5. COMMITMENTS AND CONTINGENCIES

As the result of issues generated in the ordinary course of business, the Respondent is involved in legal, tax, and regulatory proceedings before various courts, regulatory commissions, and governmental agencies, some of which involve substantial amounts of money. The Respondent believes that the final disposition of these proceedings will not have a material effect on its financial position, liquidity, or results of operations.

Taxes, Other Than Income — As a matter of course, the Respondent is regularly audited by taxing authorities. Based on internal evaluations and communications with tax authorities, the Respondent identifies uncertainties that may result from tax laws being interpreted differently by tax authorities and its use of estimates. In accordance with ASC 450, Contingencies, the Respondent recognizes liabilities for nonincome tax-related contingencies when it is probable that a liability has been incurred and the Respondent can reasonably estimate its amount. The Respondent routinely review its estimates of such liabilities when new information becomes available. As of December 31, 2013, no contingency was considered necessary. Any additional amounts that may possibly be paid to settle these matters in the future cannot be reasonably estimated at this time; however, the Respondent believes that their ultimate resolutions will not have a material effect on its financial position.

Environmental Matters — The Respondent is subject to various federal, state and local environmental and environmentally related laws and regulations. These laws and regulations, which are constantly changing, can require expenditures for remediation and may in certain instances result in assessment of fines. The Respondent has established procedures for ongoing evaluation of its operations to identify potential environmental exposures and to assure compliance with regulatory policies and procedures. The estimated costs associated with identified situations that require remedial action are accrued. However, certain costs are deferred as regulatory assets when recoverable through regulated rates. Ongoing expenditures for compliance with environmental laws and regulations, including investments in plant and facilities to meet environmental requirements, have not been material. Management believes that any such required expenditure will not be significantly different in either their nature or amount in the future and does not know of any environmental liabilities that will have a material effect on the Respondent's financial position or results of operations.
